- Speeding (over agressive driving).

- Badly secured equipment in the vehicle.

How to deal with these knowledge?

Educate to get improved attitude

- No pointing sticks or slapping the fingers.
- Just carrots, make the participant to realise that road safety is one factor to get the job done.
- Specialized education for CO and OC at every level
 - Planning, discussions, new information and new discussions...
 - My role is to be "the Devils lawyer".

Impevement of attitude

- Professionalism
- Experience based education:
 - Work with the equipment
 - Load securing, driving under different conditions and different speed (manouvering).
 - Over learning, both practical and theoretical.
 - Slippry road driving.
 - Crash and evacuation simulators.
 - The educations doesn't end when the driver has the military driving license and perhaps a civilian driving license.
