
FATIGUE

- ightarrow 15 30% of all accidents (road, rail, sea or air) are related to fatigue
- \rightarrow Swedish armed forces statutes our own regulation (exceptions from civil traffic regulations)
 - 6 hours rest in every 24 hour period
 - The natural limitations for human sets the limitations of action/possible use of personell
 - Despite this the AF need the possibility to operate 24/7
 - Possibility to operate during 72h with less than 6h rest
 - At least 24 hours recovery before new assignment



EDUCATION IN THE RISK FATIGUE

- → Education in fatigue included in the risk assessment course (included in all driver education regardless of vehicle type)
 - Total fatigue education 1,5h
 - Emphasise the humans physical limitations
 - Signs of fatigue you and others
 - Effects of fatigue
 - How to handle fatigue in the long run during excersices and education
 - Counter meassures for fatigue long/short run
 - KSS Karolinska Sleepiness Scale
 - Prediction model

NATIONAL FOCUS – SHIFT OF FOCUS

- ightarrow From mission abroad to national defence
- → Conscripts "instead" of employed soldiers and a "new" ranksystem (OR and OF instead of just OF)
- ightarrow Tactical focus shift
- → Ability to transport/move units all over the country in any conditions with limited(/no) support from MOVCON or MP
- ightarrow How to handle the air threat, comparied with the situation in a mission area?
- ightarrow Crash tests with military equipment
- ightarrow Building the total defence again including all civilian authorities and organisations
- \rightarrow Increasing budget \rightarrow bigger organisation in short time
- ightarrow Balace between tasks and resources (time)



CHALLENGES FOR THE FUTURE

- \rightarrow Strive for road safety work according ISO 39 001:2012
 - ightarrow Set meassureble road safety ambitions and indicators
 - \rightarrow Systematical followup
 - \rightarrow Implement meassures to reach
 - \rightarrow Transparancy of the development (according to Vison Zero)

Tools:

- \rightarrow Military textbook for driver education including road safety and maintenance
 - \rightarrow Ready for use in January 2021
- \rightarrow Simplify road safety regulations
- ightarrow More concretizised road safety measures in local level
- \rightarrow Followup road safety indicators in a more systematical way





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
