NEW WEBSITE

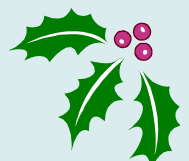

WORKING GROUPS ON STATISTICS AND LEADER TRAINING APPOINTED

ECRAF Executive Committe appointed at its first meeting two working groups on the subjects statistics and leader training.

Group 1 Statistics will be chaired by Flemming Pedersen, Denmark. He also chaired the earlier working group on the same issue. The group will have focus on accident costs.

Group 2 Leader training will be chaired by Robert Windishmann, Germany. The goal is to teach military or civilian leaders in the Armed Forces to be more aware of road safety.
